The locations listed below should surely be on your list when you are on a Kathmandu tour.

Durbar Square: The location where successive kings have sat and governed over Nepal for a very long time, as well as where new kings have been crowned to the continuous pounding of drums and trumpets. One of the three durbar squares in the nation is the opulent Kathmandu Durbar Square. The location continues to be Kathmandu's traditional architecture's most impressive heritage. Although the devastating earthquake of 2015 left its mark on the structure and caused about a dozen areas of the grounds to collapse, it has managed to retain much of its former splendour. There are three squares: Basantapur Square, the westernmost Durbar Square, and a third Durbar Square square that contains the entrance to the Hanuman Dhoka.

Swayambhu Temple: One of the most significant religious sites in Kathmandu is the Swayambhu Temple, which is perched atop Semgu Hill on the western edges of the Kathmandu Valley. This location attracts visitors on a daily basis with its white dome stupa and variety of shrines. Since it is said that doing the temple's circumference in a

clockwise orientation can wash away all of one's sins, travellers frequently execute this ritual. For Buddhists and Tibetans, the sanctuary ranks right below Lord Bouddha as one of the holiest places.

Thamel: Thamel has been and still is one of the busiest and most well-liked commercial areas in Kathmandu, Nepal. The country's tourism business has relied on the winding lanes of Thamel for more than 40 years, whether it is for taverns, cosy eateries, or spectacular temples. The Thamelneighborhood's street stores can satisfy all of your shopping needs, whether you're seeking for tasty cuisine, fashionable clothing, new music, or trekking equipment. There is free WiFi available everywhere.

Garden of Dreams: The Garden of Dreams in Kathmandu is a neo-classical garden created by Kishore Narshingh in 1920. It is also known as the "Swapna Bageecha" and the "Garden of Six Seasons." The garden attracts both locals and visitors with its beautiful amphitheatre, urns, lovely pavilions, paved perimeter walkways, pergolas, and ponds.
